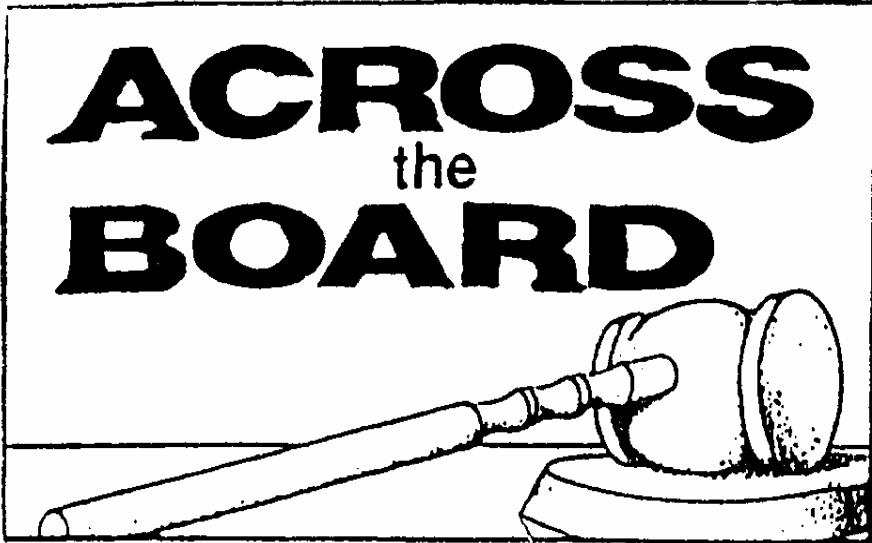

February 25, 2010: Digest of proceedings from the Office of the Superintendent.

The Board approved:

The regular meeting minutes, executive session minutes, and work session minutes from the Board of Education meeting of January 28, 2010 .

The Preliminary Monthly Budget Summary Report for the 2009-10 school year through December 2009.

December 2009 Board Secretary Report for the 2009-10 school year, pending audit.

December 2009 preliminary report of the Treasurer of School funds for the 2009-10 school year.

Payment of bills.

School district investments.

The list of out of district staff development workshops and professional development activities.

The list of field trips.

April 20, 2010 from 4 p.m. until 9 p.m. for the Annual School Board Election at the regional polling places.

Drawing positions for the ballot on March 10, 2010 at 4 p.m. in the Board of Education Office.

The submission of the 2010-11 school district budget to the County Superintendent of Schools by March

23, 2010 and to apply for any statutory spending limitations as needed. The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent of Schools and the Business Administrator to make all necessary changes to the budget once all state aid is released by the governor and the New Jersey Department of Education.

The tuition rates for the 2010-11 school year as follows:

Grades 6 through 8	\$11,242.
Grades 9 through 12	\$11,097.

The adjusted Cape May Point tuition for the 2007-08 and 2008-09 school years that shows a balance due to Cape May Point School District in the amount of \$1,072. We are anticipating 2 high school regular education students and 0 Teitelman regular education students to attend the Lower Cape May Regional School District for the 2010-11 school year. The anticipated tuition will be a total of \$22,194, minus \$1,072 for a total of \$21,122.
